INFRASTRUCTURE LEVY BYLAW


A BYLAW TO RAISE FUNDS FOR THE REPLACEMENT AND REPAIR OF GENERAL INFRASTRUCTURE WITHIN THE TOWN OF MOSSBANK.

The Council of the Town of Mossbank in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw shall be known as the "Infrastructure Levy Bylaw".
2. Persons who own or occupy premises shall pay a levy of one hundred twenty dollars (\$120.00) per year, charged at thirty dollars (\$30.00) per billing quarter to fund replacement and repair of general infrastructure in the Town of Mossbank. Stub periods shall be pro-rated accordingly.
3. Accounts shall be paid within thirty (30) days of billing.
4. Bylaw No. 03/15 is hereby repealed.
5. The levy contained in this bylaw shall come into force and take effect immediately prior to the beginning of the billing period following approval being issued by the Local Government Committee of the Saskatchewan Municipal Board.
