TOWN OF MOSSBANK

BYLAW NO. 178/87

A BYLAW WITH RESPECT TO LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY

The Council of the Town of Mossbank of the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. No person shall herd cattle at any time within the limits of the town.
- 2. No person shall graze any cattle, nor shall any cattle be permitted to graze at any time within the area bounded by a plan of the Town of Mossbank and made up by the Community Planning Services Branch.
- 3. No person shall keep any livestock or poultry at any time within the area bounded by a plan of the Town of Mossbank made up by the Community Planning Services Branch.
- 4. No person shall keep any livestock or poultry at any time beyond the area designated in Section 3 hereof except within a barn, shed, or poultry pen especially erected for such purpose and approved by the town council.
- 5. Any person who infringes any of the provisions of this bylaw or fails to comply therewith shall be liable on summary conviction to the provisions of the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town of Mossbank.

This Bylaw shall take effect and come into force on the date of final passing thereof.
