TOWN OF MOSSBANK

BYLAW NO. 173/87

A bylaw to extend the permitted use of plastic plumbing materials.

Under the provisions of Section 83 of the Public Health Act, R.S.S. 1978, the Council of the Town of Mossbank of Mossbank, Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Saskatchewan Plumbing and Drainage Regulations, 1978, enacted under the Public Health Act the Associated Gospel Church of Mossbank, Saskatchewan is hereby authorized to use plastic pipe and fittings in the plumbing system serving the structure known as Associated Gospel Church located on lots 9, 10 & 11 of Block 16 CN, Plan # CX 530.
- 2. The construction of such plumbing shall comply to the requirements stipulated under subsection (a) and (b):
 - a) Combustible drain, waste and vent piping shall not be used in a plumbing system within a building where part of the system is located within or passes through a fire separation required to have a fire-resistance rating, except that where drain, waste and vent piping penetrates through a vertical fire separation, the piping on one side may be combustible provided the combustible piping is not located in a vertical shaft or in a fire separation required to have a fire-resistance rating.
 - b) Meet the requirements imposed by:
 - i) The office of the Provincial Fire Commissioner.
- 3. This bylaw shall come into force and effect upon approval of the Minister of Health.
