A BYLAW WITH RESPECT TO LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY

The Council of the Town of Mossbank follows: of the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as

- No person shall herd cattle at any time within the limits of the town.
- 2 No person shall graze any cattle, nor shall any cattle be permitted to graze at any time within the area bounded by a plan of the Town of Mossbank and made up by the Community Planning Services Branch.
- ω No person shall keep any livestock or poultry at any time within the area bounded by a plan of the Town of Mossbank made up by the Community Planning Services Branch.
- 4. No person shall keep any livestock or poultry at any time beyond the area designated in Section 3 hereof except within a barn, shed, or poultr pen especially erected for such purpose and approved by the town council. time beyond the barn, shed, or poultry
- Ģ Any person who infringes any of the to comply therewith shall be liable the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town of Mossbank. provisions of this bylaw on summary conviction to or fails the provisions
