

TOWN OF MOSSBANK

BYLAW NO.25

A bylaw prohibiting the discharge of guns and, or, other firearms within the limits of the Town of Mossbank.

The Council of the town of Mossbank in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- (1) That guns and firearms shall also include air-guns and spring-guns, or any class or type thereof.
- (2) That said firearms shall not be discharged within the town limits.
- (3) That said firearms shall not be carried by hand or in a vehicle with live ammunition in the magazine or firing chamber within the Town limits.
- (4) This bylaw shall not apply to a Police Officer or other authorized person.
- (5) Anyone violating the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties under the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town of Mossbank, being Bylaw no. 21, passed March 16th, 1964.
