BYLAW NO. 5/14

**A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A
MUTUAL AID AREA**

The Council of the Town of Mossbank in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. In this bylaw:
 - a. “Administrator” shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
 - b. “Council” shall mean the council of the municipality;
 - c. “Municipality” shall mean the Town of Mossbank;
- 2. The Town of Mossbank is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Council of the Rural Municipality of Lake Johnston No. 102, and with the Council of the Rural Municipality of Sutton No. 103
- 3. The Mayor and Administrator are hereby authorized to sign and execute an agreement, the terms of which are set out in Exhibit “A” here before referred to.
- 4. Bylaw No. 206/94 is hereby repealed.

This agreement made this 14th day of April, 2014

Between:

The Rural Municipality of Lake Johnston No. 102

and

The Rural Municipality of Sutton No. 103

and

The Town of Mossbank

This agreement witnessed as follows:

1. That the parties to this agreement form a Mutual Aid Area.
2. That each party to this agreement will assist any other party to the agreement in the event of an emergent situation or disaster.
3. That the Mossbank Municipal Office shall be recognized as the Emergency Response Centre.
4. That the objectives of the Mutual Aid Area are:
 - a. a resource base to be expanded by pooling local resources
 - b. an increased capacity of communities to deal with emergent events
 - c. to adopt a unified partnership with neighboring communities to provide reciprocal assistance, expertise, and resources in a declared disaster or emergency situation
 - d. to provide effective communication
 - e. to prepare resource lists in each community including equipment and manpower.
5. That, without limiting the general activities of the Mutual Aid Area, priorities include:
 - a. to hold regular area meetings
 - b. to prepare and update resource manuals
 - c. to secure Emergency Response Unit(s) and equipment
 - d. determining the priorities of all partners (i.e. training, plan development, etc.)
 - e. exercising together
 - f. determining how we will support each other
 - g. to define duties, roles, and responsibilities
 - h. to develop and implement the planning and publicity projects
6. That this agreement shall be continuous, however, any party to the agreement may withdraw from the agreement by giving each other party to the agreement sixty (60) days' notice to withdraw.
