BYLAW NO. 195/90

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS.

THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MOSSBANK, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- $l_{\rm eM}$ This bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw" of the municipality.
- 2. Section 3 applies only to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other fine is provided.
- 3. Subject to the provisions of section 2, any individual found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of The Urban Municipality Act, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$2,000 and costs for every offence.
- 4. Subject to the provisions of section 2, any corporation found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by authority of The Urban Municipality Act, shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$5,000 and costs for every offence.
- 5. Bylaw No. 118 passed November 10, 1980 and Bylaw No. 118A passed February 9, 1981 are hereby repealed.
