WATER RESTRICTION BYLAW

A BYLAW TO RESTRICT WATER USAGE

The Council of the Town of Mossbank in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw shall be known as the “Water Restriction Bylaw”.
2. On the advice of the Water Treatment Plant Operator and/or the Administrator, The Town of Mossbank may issue water conservation measures for any consumers of water provided by the Town of Mossbank Water Treatment Plant.
3. The water conservation measures may include but are not limited to restrictions for the use of water for grass, gardens, swimming pools, or any outdoor use of water.
4. The issuance of water conservation measures will be made by posting a notice in the Town Office and any public notice boards, social media, or online sources available, stating the details of the water restrictions and the effective date.
5. Anyone found to be in contravention of a water conservation measure restriction issued pursuant to this bylaw may have their water connection terminated without notice and be fined not more than \$2500.00.
